Survey conducted August 23 to August 25, 2022. 1,500 likely 2022 General Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2022 General Election.

Margin of Error is +/-2.6% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.



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In 2020, Colorado voters passed Proposition 114 that mandates that the Colorado Parks and Wildlife begin restoring gray wolves as a non-game species, a species that cannot be hunted, to Colorado by the end of 2023.
